TODAY'S GAME: Jackson looks to win its 4th straight series tonight and win their 4th straight game in the middle game of the 3-game series against the M-Braves. The Generals are in a stretch of playing 17-straight games (9-6) against the South Division.

GENERALS RECAP: In a record setting night at Pringles Park, the Generals blasted the M-Braves in the opener of the 3-game series, 16-6. The Generals set a Southern League record for most doubles in a game with 11 and tied a league record with 13 extra-base hits. Jackson also set season-highs in runs and hits, with 18 knocks. 8 Generals collected extra-base hits (Nate Tenbrink (3x5, 3 2B), Rich Poythress (2x4, 294), Denny Almonte (3x6, 4 RBI), Joe Dunigan (2x4, 3 RBI), Leury Bonilla (2x4, 2B, RBI), Chih-Hsien Chiang (2x4, 2B, RBI), Gabriel Noriega (2x5, RBI), Jesus Sucre (2x5, 2B, RBI)). RH Brandon Maurer (6-2, 3.87 ERA) pitched 5.0 solid innings before a rocky 6th inning. Maurer allowed 5 earned runs on 4 hits, walked 2 and struck out 6 in the win. LH Jose Jimenez earned the hold, striking out 2 in 1.1 innings of work.

RECORD SETTING NIGHT: Last night, the Generals broke the Southern League record for doubles in one game with 11, eclipsing the previous mark of 10 set by the Mobile BayBears on May 25, 2000. The Generals also matched the league mark with 13 extra-base hits, becoming the first team to do so without the benefit of a homer.

TOPS IN THE LEAGUE: The Generals 54-36 record is the best in the Southern League. Also, Jackson ranks 1st in pitching, with a 3.12 ERA. The Generals lead the league with 68 home runs and rank 2nd in the league with 96 stolen bases.

GENERALS V BRAVES: The Generals and M-Braves meet 16 times this season and 13 times at Pringles Park. This season Jackson leads the series 6-3, while the the all-time series is tied 76-76. Jackson has a 2.09 ERA against the Braves this season and has belted 6 home runs.

BACK FROM THE FUTURE: Former General Danny Hultzen (1.0,3,1,1,0,1) allowed 1 run on 3 hits and struck out 1 in 1.0 inning, while current General **Taijuan Walker** (1.0,1,0,0,0,1) tossed a scoreless 7th inning, in the MLB All-Star Futures game yesterday in Kansas City. Jackson manager Jim Pankovits served as third base coach for U.S. Manager George Brett. Tigers prospect Nick Castellanos went 3x4 with a 3-run homer and 3 runs scored as the U.S. trounced the World team, 17-5, at the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Kauffman Stadium in Kansas City on Sunday afternoon.

VIVA LA ROMERO: INF Stefen Romero went 0x2 Monday, ending his hitting streak at 9 games. During the streak he hit .378 (14x37) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 13 RBI. He has hit safely 15 of 17 games with 10 multi-hit games with Jackson since his promotion, batting .369 (25x65) with 12 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triple, 3 home runs and 21 RBI. In 3 starts since being promoted for High Desert to Jackson,

CAPPING OFF GAMES: RH Carter Capps has allowed only 2 earned runs (3 R) over his last 30.1 (0.59 ERA). This season he is 2-3 with 15 saves and a 1.47 ERA (7 ER, 43.0 IP). He has limited opponents to a .210 (34x162) average, while walking 12 and striking out 63. Capps has held opponents scoreless in 28 of 32 relief appearances this season.

CHECKING IN ON MARTINEZ: Generals infielder Francisco Martinez, currently rehabbing with the AZL Mariners has played in 4 games, batting .385 (5x13), with 2 triples and 5 RBI. Martinez was placed on the DL June 7th with a pulled hamstring.

IFEEL A DRAFT: The Mariners selected 41 players in the 2012 First-Year Player Draft held June 4-6, highlighted by their first pick, Golden Spikes Award winner catcher **Mike Zunino** from the University of Florida, who was the 3rd overall pick in the draft...overall selected 20 pitchers (14 RHP, 6 LHP), 3 catchers, 13 infielders (3 1B, 3 2B, 1 3B, 6 SS) and 5 outfielders...

FERNANDEZ MANIA: LH **Anthony Fernandez** became the first Jackson pitcher in franchise history to post back-to-back 9-inning complete games in his first 2 starts. Fernandez has won each of his first 4 Double-A starts, allowing just 4 ER in 30.0 IP, including a 2-hit, complete game shutout on June 28th at Pensacola. Fernandez is 4-0, with a 1.20 ERA.

WHO'S HOT?: RH Yoervis Medina has allowed 1 run in his last 22.2 innings in relief (0.38 ERA). During this 15 game stretch has limited opponents to a .203 (16x79) average, while walking 8 and striking out 25.

FIRST HALF CHAMPIONS: Jackson won their 4th first half Championship in club history with a 42-28 record and ended the half with a 7-game lead in the division. The 42 first half wins ranked 3rd all-time in franchise history during a first half.

Tonight's Start: 23-year-old right-hander Forrest Snow makes his 6th Jackson start tonight in the middle game agains the M-Braves. This is the Seattle, WA native's 72nd career outing and 38th career start.

<u>Last Outing:</u> Snow allowed 5 runs on 4 hits, while walking 5 and striking out 3 Saturday at Montgomery, taking the loss. The 5 walks matched a season-high for Snow. The Generals lost the opener to the Biscuits 7-2.

<u>Top Rated Prospect:</u> Snow is rated as the No. 19 prospect for the Mariners according to Baseball America.

<u>Transferred to Jackson:</u> Snow was sent to Jackson from AAA Tacoma on 6/14 as LHP Bobby LaFromboise and RHP Steven Hensley were promoted to Tacoma. Snow was 1-4, with a 8.42 ERA for the Rainiers in 13 games and 11 starts.

Personal History for Snow: Forrest's father, Fielding, played baseball at San Diego State...Forrest graduated from the Lakeside School (Seattle, WA) in June, 2007...named first-team All-Metro League and honorable mention all-state as a junior and senior...played on a Northwest All-Star "Mariners Cup" team that played against a California all-star team...drafted by Seattle in the 44th round of 2007 June draft, but did not sign...

Attended the U of Washington: attended the University of Washington from 2008-10...went 6-2 in 46 career appearances (12 starts) for the Huskies.

Jump from Single-A to Triple-A in 2011: Split season between Clinton (April 7-June 14), High Desert (June 15-July 23) and Tacoma (July 24-end of season)...finished 4th amongst all Mariners farmhands with 127 strike-outs...after serving as Clinton's closer in 2010, made move to rotation and was Opening Night starter on April 7 vs. Burlington (3.0,4,4,3,2,4,WP,HB)... tossed first-career complete game April 29 at Wisconsin (G#2), allowing 1 run in 7.0 innings (7.0,5,1,1,1,7,HR)...struck out a career-high 9 batters twice with Tacoma: July 24 at Salt Lake City (6.0,7,3,3,1,9,HR) and Aug. 17 vs. Omaha (7.0,4,1,1,1,9)...played for the Peoria in the Arizona Fall League...led AFL with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER, 16.1 IP), and 2nd in opponent avg (.167) and WHIP (0.80)...

<u>Start of Pro Career:</u> Began pro career with Everett...tossed 25.1 scoreless innings over 10 appearances...promoted to Clinton on July 28...converted 6 of 7 save opportunities and finished 2nd on the club in that category...participated in Mariners Instructional League.
